**SUPPLY LIST**

5-day class

I look forward to helping you explore color in fascinating ways. In class you will play with paint, color pencils, and fabric. You will learn so much from our painting exercises! During the workshop you will begin a quilt project of your choice, in which you incorporate at least one new color idea.

**Day 1---Paint Day** (Please wear old clothes appropriate for a paint day.)

1. Bring paper scissors, pencil, ruler, eraser, glue stick, and colored pencils. You may also bring a dull rotary cutter and a cutting board for cutting paper.
2. You will need 2-3 packages of 3" x 5" non-lined index cards, 100 cards per pack. If possible, also bring one piece of large, sturdy black paper for your color wheel's background (larger than 8 ½ x 11"). Also bring many pages of large, white drawing paper (you can share a pad of drawing paper with your friends, if you wish).
3. Bring paint brushes. Bring 2-3 1" flat, nylon brushes that are moderately priced. You do not need expensive brushes, but cheap brushes fall apart easily. As an alternative, you may work with sponge brushes, if you prefer. Bring several.
4. Bring approximately 1 dozen shallow, open containers to mix paints in, at least 2 containers for holding water and washing brushes; mixing tools, such as coffee stirrers; 2-4 plastic spoons or knives, and several toothpicks. Bring paper towels for cleaning up. (Please do not bring containers that are porous, and therefore absorb paint.) As an alternative to containers and mixing tools, bring a palette knife and paint palette, if you have them. Also, if you want, you can bring a piece of old fabric to wipe paint from brushes. An old or inexpensive small kitchen spatula may come in handy during your painting.
5. I will bring the paints to class. To keep this cost as affordable as possible, the *basic* paints will be shared for color-wheel painting; in other exploration, paints will not be shared. The **paint fee will be approximately \$25** (I will let you know in class if it is less).

**Bring these additional items to class on the second day:**

6. fabric scissors or a sharp rotary cutter and board for fabric exercises; pins
7. a wide variety of fabrics—(1) pure, brilliant colors; (2) light, clear colors, tints; (3) dark, rich shades; and (4) grayed-down colors, tones. Also bring fabrics in a wide value range (light to dark). If you are not certain about the above-stated criteria, bring whatever suits your fancy—and as many as possible....within reason.

### **Your Quilt Project**

1. Select a project you would love to do. It can be a quilt of any style, size, technique, or coloration.
2. Bring a wide selection of fabrics for this project in the colors you want to work in. Also, bring all of your favorite cutting equipment, rotary cutter, mat, ruler, or other cutting tools. Also, bring your favorite basic supplies for sewing (e.g. pins, thread, needles, etc.). You will need a sewing machine with basic accessories (including a new needle)

### **Optional:**

1. If you have the book *Color Play*, bring it for a reference. If possible, read the first two chapters of *Color Play* prior to class.
2. If you have a *3-in-1 Color Tool*, bring it too.
3. If you have an Ott Lite or other similar light, you should bring it.
4. Consider bringing small surge protector.
